Parents meeting at Churwell

On 2 June a group of parents met Mrs Curtis to discuss issues around having PLAY@Churwell based in school. The outcome was that space in school was limited in term time but that there was a possibility of use for two weeks in the summer. We are following this offer up with Mrs Curtis but parents need to be aware that the premises would need to be registered for childcare with OFSTED before we would be allowed to use it for a playscheme.

Whatever the location, you can be assured we will make sure it is safe and offer the full range of activities offered in previous playschemes and more if we have the advantage of outside play space.

Give us your view

We want to know your views on a move to Asquith Primary School and whether you would keep your place in September. Please complete the attached and return by **Friday 27 June**.

A base at Asquith would mean we would have access to outdoor play space and the walk to school would be safer as away from the main road, although it is a slightly longer journey.

Maintaining a base in Churwell would be preferable but we need to minimize hire charges to enable us to keep our fees affordable and in line with other out of school groups in Morley. Hiring Back Green is not feasible with current numbers. Our long term aim is run two groups at both Churwell School and Asquith School.

We appreciate it is difficult as you have not had the chance to look at Asquith. At present the majority of the school is used by Summerfield while their school in Bramley is being rebuilt so we cannot show you around. We'll arrange an Open Day in the summer for parents and children. If you have concerns before then please contact Cath to discuss. She is familiar with the layout of Asquith School and the walking route to Churwell.
